Traditional measurement techniques can be expensive, slow, and less safe

A common problem for contractors, like Turner Mining Group, is tracking the volumes of material moved. Invoicing is based on these volumes. Contractors can often end up in costly and timeconsuming disputes with clients over how much material was moved on a given site or project.

Historically, Turner would hire a surveying company to go on site with GPS rovers to collect the data. While each point a surveyor takes is quite accurate, they would only take a few hundred points. New technology, like drones, is much more accurate. Instead of a couple hundred points, you have a couple hundred thousand points. Turner had to schedule the surveyor to come out, typically only at the beginning and end of a contract. In addition to the inaccuracy, traditional methods involve shutting down operating areas so that the surveyors can climb on the pile, which is dangerous, and includes a couple weeks of turnaround time to get the results back. This method is less safe than new technology methods and is difficult to reconcile billings quickly.

Turner was frustrated by the inefficiencies created by these old methods and the costs of the disputes. When drone technology became a viable solution for inventory measurements and mapping, the team jumped at the chance to implement a new system that is easy, efficient, and safe.

How Turner Mining Group Uses Drone Solutions

Turner's adoption of Firmatek's Drone Solutions allows them to collect data and ensure correct volumes are reported when it makes sense for them, such as at the beginning, middle, and end of a project. Instead of having to hire a surveyor to come out on site on a specific day, Turner Mining Group employees fly the drone on site the days they need to use it. This typically includes a pre and post-site scan. On larger projects, they may do flights monthly or in the middle of the project. They use these numbers to reconcile what they have been reporting for truck payloads and to be sure they are on target to meet production requirements. If they are not, they make adjustments to their processes before it is too late. It has become so easy that their standard is to fly every site they are working at monthly.

The drone solutions process is fast and easy. It typically takes a Turner employee about 45 minutes from start to finish to capture the data on the site. Then they hand it off to Firmatek and get their results. The full-service model of Firmatek's solution fits their needs better than some of the more Do-It-Yourself models available today. The Safety Factor

Drones are significantly safer than other surveying methods, whether it is a surveyor walking on piles or even mobile LiDAR where the technician is driving around a site. One person can stand out of the way and fly the drone. He never needs to be near an active area.

For this reason, the safety factor of drones is a big selling point for this technology for Turner Mining Group. Previously, the crews would have to shut down while a surveyor was on site measuring. Now, they don't lose that production time. So in addition to being more cost effective overall, drones also mean less down time.
